

Admission Criteria for CNA Training

Complete C.N.A. additional application and provide the following documentation:

- Proof of minimum age of 17 years
- Completed Health Exam Form & physical exam within 6 months of program start date (Candidate must be able to lift 50 lbs to the waist)
- Proof of TB test dated less than 12 months prior to program start date
- Proof of (dated) MMR immunization records or Titer Certificate showing immunity
- Proof of (dated) Flu Shot for within 12 months of program start date
- <u>2 Forms of ID are required</u>
- Primary ID must be a government issued photo ID such as a driver's license
- Secondary form of ID, must have a matching (same name) signature
- Submit application and documents to FM Admissions Office. If you are being sponsored by an agency, you must include a letter of commitment from the sponsor with your application and documentation. If you are not being sponsored and paying out of pocket, you will need make full payment with the Bursar by due date prior to class start. For payment information contact the Bursar: 518-736-3622 ext. 8600. If you qualify for any financial aid or scholarships, this will be applied to your account after and refunded to you. Payment is due in full at time of registration.
- You must attest to having a clear criminal record (<u>absolutely no</u> <u>misdemeanors or felonies</u>)
- CNA uniform requirements: Appropriate scrubs (pants/tops) and healthcare worker shoes (sneakers) to be worn for clinical training (not included in your fee).
