Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree in Cybersecurity, Computer Science, Computer Information Systems, Information Technology, Software Engineering, or closely related field from a regionally accredited institution is required. Master's degree preferred. The successful candidate must earn a master's degree within five years of initial appointment.
- Previous teaching experience is preferred.
- Knowledge of Computer Applications, Hardware, Networking, Linux Operating System, and Internet programming.
- Familiarity with current trends in Cybersecurity, Networking, and emerging technologies is highly valued.
