

Human Services Instructor for Spring 2025

Duties include, but are not limited to, planning, evaluation, and assessment of student learning and program curriculum.

Qualifications: A Master's degree in Human Services, Social Work, or a closely related field is required. Criminal Justice or Addiction Services background preferred. Teaching experience is preferred, preferably at the two-year college level, as is experience with assessment of student learning.
