

Mathematics Instructor

Candidates should be prepared to teach a range of courses, from remedial to advanced mathematics and statistics. Candidates must be committed to the mission of community colleges and teaching students who have a wide range of academic abilities. Additional responsibilities include, but are not limited to, assessment, planning, and implementation and evaluation of curriculum.

Qualifications:

- A Master's degree in Mathematics or Mathematics Education combined with a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics are required.
- Teaching experience is preferred, preferably at the two-year college level.
- Experience with assessment of student learning is also preferred.
