The successful candidate will teach:

- ELT125 – Electric Circuit Analysis I (Fall 2026)
- ELT126 – Electric Circuit Analysis II (Spring 2027)

These courses include both lecture and laboratory components and focus on foundational and intermediate electrical circuit analysis, including DC/AC circuit laws, network theorems, instrumentation, and applied lab experimentation. Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering, Physics, or closely related discipline is required. A Master's degree is preferred.
- Teaching experience is preferred, preferably at the two-year college level.
