College in the High School - Billing / Drop Due to Non-Payment

SUNY Fulton-Montgomery Community College has implemented a new procedure for student accounts with unpaid balances. Any College in High School account that is outstanding by the noted due date will be dropped from the course(s) and the student will not receive college credit for that course(s). This change is effective beginning Fall 2024.

<u>Certificate of Residence (CR)</u> – Please also be reminded that students who reside outside of Fulton or Montgomery counties are required to provide a Certificate of Residence (CR). Students who fail to provide a valid CR prior to the deadline noted below will also be dropped from their registered courses. If a student is registered after the deadline to submit their CR, they will need to appeal to their county to waive their deadline and issue a CR on their behalf. If the county issues the late CR, the student must submit that CR to the college by the next business day.

If a student who is dropped due to non-payment or failure to submit a CR would still like to participate in the College in the High School program, the student must submit a written appeal request to the Academic and Finance Review Panel for their review and consideration.
